

Elizabethtown Fair Scholarship

Eligibility Criteria

1. The Elizabethtown Fair scholarship award is to be used to help finance a post-secondary education at an institution of higher learning.
2. Students will only be eligible to receive this scholarship one time. This will allow more students the opportunity to receive this award.
3. Two applicants will be awarded a \$500 scholarship to be paid to the post-secondary institution.
4. Scholarships are available to any individual who has participated at the Elizabethtown Fair for at least two years.
5. Applicant must be a graduating high school senior or currently enrolled in a post-secondary educational institution and not observed their 21st birthday as of January 1st of the current year.
6. Selection will be based on the following:
 - High School/College Activities
 - Achievements, Leadership, Involvement
 - 4-H, FFA, Service Organizations
 - Achievements, Leadership, Involvement, Community Service
 - Elizabethtown Fair Participation
 - Volunteer Involvement, Achievements, Participation
 - Transcripts - High School, College
 - References (Two Letters of Recommendation)
 - Essay
7. The applicant will prepare an essay introducing themselves. It should include background information, career aspirations, Elizabethtown Fair participation (exhibiting, volunteer work, etc.) and how this award will be a benefit to them.
8. Scholarship winners will be recognized and honored during the Elizabethtown Fair opening ceremony.
9. Applicant must submit a completed application, essay and all required documentation **postmarked** by June 15 to:
